#### Note:

- 1. 3 subjects including English Language, Mathematics Syllabus D and Bengali are Compulsory Subjects for all students.
- 2. Each student must choose minimum 3 optional subjects.
- 3. Each student may choose maximum 7 optional subjects.
- 4. Each student will attend Extra-curricular activity courses (on-campus only) unless they have any assigned parallel optional subject.
- 5. A student having ten subjects (3 compulsory + 7 optional) will have no access to attend any extracurricular activity course.
- 6. A student will register in class 10 for O-Level May-June 2024 Exams for at least 6 subjects (3 compulsory + 3 optional).
- 7. Classes and exams for Art & Design will be conducted after the regular class/exam is over once a week.
- 8. No written examinations will be held for extra-curricular activity courses. The students will be evaluated in class and certificate will be awarded at the end of the session.
- 9. Students studying any parallel subjects from the optional ones may have no access to classes and exam facilities in general. However, if they apply in writing, in special circumstances department may arrange classes and exams if possible for those particular students.
- 10. Students may be allowed to register for additional subjects not offered by MDIC during May-June 2024 or October-November 2024 series of CAIE. But the students will have no access to classes and exam facilities. They will not get transcripts or Assessed Grades/Predicted Grades, etc.
- 11. Students will submit the Subject Choice Form to class teacher of class 9 by Thursday, 11 August 2022. Students will submit the original subject choice form to class teacher and keeping a photocopy.
- 12. Any student changing any subject must submit an application along with the corrected subject choice form to class teacher. The option for changing subject will remain open up to 1<sup>st</sup> week of October 2022.
